

Microscopy

Section examined shows squamous lining epithelium with small round nucleus. Deeper tissue shows fibrocollagneous tissue, blood vessels with inflammatory cells (Polymorphs, Lymphcytes and Plasma cells). Section also shows membraneous tissue. No well-formed granuloma seen. No malignant cells seen.
