

SPECIMEN Intestinal Biopsy **GROSS** Received multiple tiny grayish white tissue piece.

Microscopy

Section examined shows mucosal lining epithelial with columnar cells with round to oval nucleus. deeper tissue shows submucosal glands with large numbers of inflammatory cells(Polymorphs, Lymphocytes and occasional histiocytes) with blood vessels and necrosis. No granuloma seen. No malignant cells seen.
