

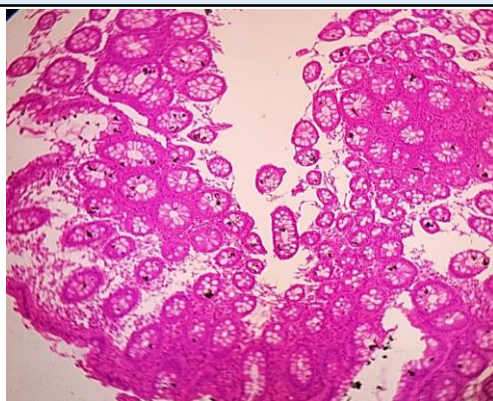

Intestinal Biopsy

GROSS

Received multiple tiny grayish white tissue piece.

Microscopy

Section examined shows mucosal lining epithelial with columnar cells with round to oval nucleus. deeper tissue shows submucosal glands with large numbers of inflammatory cells (Polymorphs, Lymphocytes and occasional histiocytes) with blood vessels and necrosis. No granuloma seen. No malignant cells seen.

Note : All biopsy specimen will be stored for 15 (fifteen) days, block and slides for 5 (five) years only from the time of receipt at the laboratory. No request, for any of the above, will be entertained after the due date.
