

Swelling Lower Lip

DIAGNOSIS

ORAL FIBROMA



SPECIMEN Swelling Lower Lip GROSS

Received tiny grayish white tissue piece.

Microscopy

- 1. Section examined shows atrophic to hyperplastic stratified squamous lining epithelium with round to oval nucleus.
- 2. Deeper tissue shows bundles of collagen fibers interspersed with fibroblasts and fibrocytes, few inflammatory cells (lymphocytes and plasma cells), blood capillaries and normal muscle bundles.
- 3. No granuloma seen.
- 4. No malignant cells seen.

Note : All biopsy specimen will be stored for 15 (fifteen)days, block and slides for 5(five) years only from the time of receipt at the laboratory. No request , for any of the above , will be entertained after the due date.
