

### GROSS

Received two containers with tiny greyish white tissue piece each contained.

#### Microscopy

Section examined shows mononuclear inflammatory cells with occassional submucosal glands having mild anisonucleosis. Section also shows villi with columnar lining epithelium with small round to oval nucleus. Deeper tissue shows fibrocollagneous tissue, mononuclear inflamamtory cells with histiocytes.

No cryptic abscess seen. No granuloma seen. No malignant cells seen.
