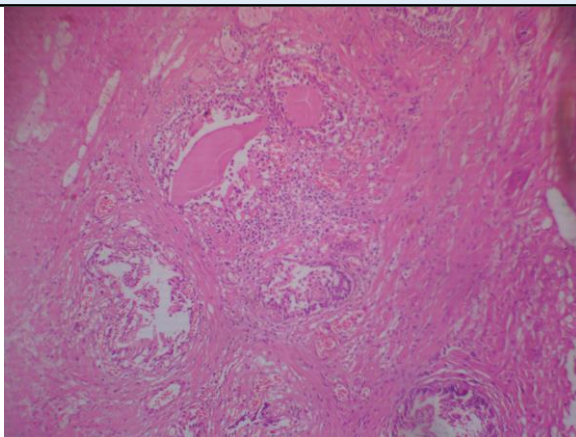

DIAGNOSIS

SUGGESTIVE OF BENIGN PROSTATIC HYPERPLASIA

ADVISED: PSA co-relation with deeper biopsy.

GROSS

Received multiple grayish white tissue piece, 2x2 cm in aggregate.

Microscopy

Section examined shows few prostatic glands with large number of stromal cells, blood vessels and inflammatory cells.
