

Received 10.2x3.8cm long gall bladder already cut open with tiny stones. Wall Thickness 0.4 mm.

Microscopy

Section examined shows ulcerative mucosa and rokitansky aschoff sinus (irregularly shaped tubular structures lined by cuboidal lining epithelium with round to oval nucleus) with fibro collagenous tissue and inflammatory cells (lymphocytes).
