

Received 4.5x3 cm testis with epididymus. Cut section shows necrotic changes.

Microscopy

Section examined shows effacement of testicular architecture with loss of mature and immature spermatogenic cells with large number of polymorphs, pus cells and lymphcytes.

No granuloma seen. No malignant cells seen.

Epididymus is unremarkable.
