

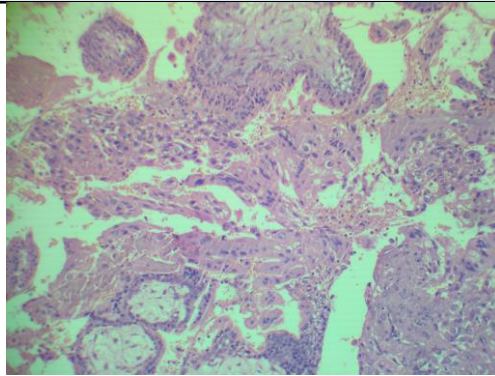

#### **Microscopy**

Section examined shows trophoblastic cells and blood clot.  
No granuloma seen. No malignant cells seen.
