

#### **GROSS**

Received autolyzed 10x4cm long gall bladder. Cut section shows stones. Wall Thickness 0.2 mm.

### Microscopy

Section examined shows autolytic changes with ulcerative mucosa and rokitansky aschoff sinus (irregularly shaped tubular structures lined by cuboidal lining epithelium with round to oval nucleus) with fibro collagenous tissue and inflammatory cells (lymphocytes).
