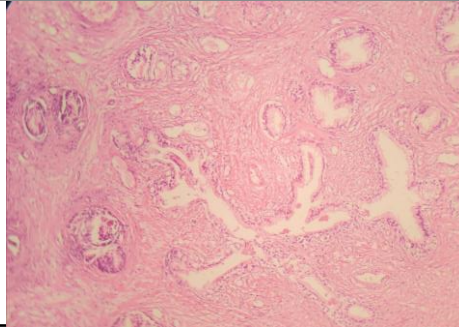

BENIGN PROSTATIC HYPERPLASIA WITH PROSTATITIS

TURP Chips

GROSS

Received multiple grayish white tissue piece, 4x4 cm in aggregate.

Microscopy

Section examined shows bilayered to multilayered prostatic glands with columnar lining epithelium and with small round to oval nucleus surrounded by large number of fibrocollagenous tissue and large number of inflammatory cell.

No granuloma seen. No malignant cells seen.
