

### **Screen Negative**

This patient's relative risk for Down syndrome has been determined by dividing the assay results by the average analyte level in twin pregnancies, and then calculating the risk associated with a singleton pregnancy. This relative risk calculation places the patient below the screening cut-off for Down syndrome.

**OPEN NEURAL TUBE DEFECT Screen Negative**The maternal serum AFP result is NOT elevated for a TWIN pregnancy of this
gestational age. The risk of an open neural tube defect is less than the risk at
the TWIN screening cut-off. Twin pregnancies have serum AFP
concentrations that are twice those seen in singleton pregnancies.
