**BEFORE SURGERY**

1. Get the following investigations done

- a) Blood Sugar (F) and (P.P.)
- b) Urine routine examination
- c) Blood Pressure
- d) ECG
- e) HIV, HCV & HBsAG ⊕ Covid RT-PCR

The investigations should be done early so that if there is any need for medical control the parameters it can be done before the surgery.

2. Put Moxicip eye drops Four times a day in the eye to be operated including on the morning of Surgery 1 hour before arrival.

Put Zolvimac-ES eye drops 3 times a day in the eye to be operated including on the morning of Surgery 1 hour before arrival

**ONE DAY PRIOR TO SURGERY**

- Take a thorough bath including a head bath with soap & water.
- Continue to take medicines for systemic conditions as before, unless advised otherwise.
- If any **anticoagulants like Aspirin** is being used, please **discontinue** the drugs the day before the date of operation after consulting your physician.

**ON THE MORNING OF SURGERY**

1. In case you suffer from Hypertension, Diabetes or any other general condition, take the medicines prescribed to you in the morning.

You may carry out your normal morning routine.

You may take a light breakfast as desired.

Please put all the following eye drops in the eye to be operated at a gap of 5 minutes on three occasions every half an hour starting at

- a) Tropicacyl 1%
  - b) Cyclomid 1%
- on the day of Sx.

Report at the Reception desk of the UPE at 30 SFR

You are generally called a little while prior to the time of surgery. This is necessary for operative preparation and because your pupils need to be dilated further with

Kindly remove all cash and other valuables before you prepare to go into the operation room. You will be wearing the gown provided to you.

You must make it a point to go to the toilet before you go in for the operation.
