



Risk	Down's Syndrome Risk (Trisomy 21 Screening)
 <p>The graph shows Age Risk (1:1420) and Combined Risk (<1:10000) plotted against Age (13-49). A red area above the cut-off line indicates risk above the cut-off, a yellow area below the cut-off but above the age risk line indicates risk above age risk, and a green area below the age risk line indicates risk below age risk.</p>	<p>The calculated risk for Trisomy 21 (with NT) is below the cut off, which represents a low risk.</p> <p>After the result of the Trisomy 21 test it is expected that among more than 10000 women with the same data, there is one woman with a trisomy 21 pregnancy and 9999 women with not affected pregnancies. The calculated risk by PRISCA depends on the accuracy of the information provided by the referring physician. Please note that the risk calculations are statistical approaches and have no diagnostic value!</p>

The calculated risk for Trisomy 13/18 with NT is <1:10000, which indicates a low risk
