



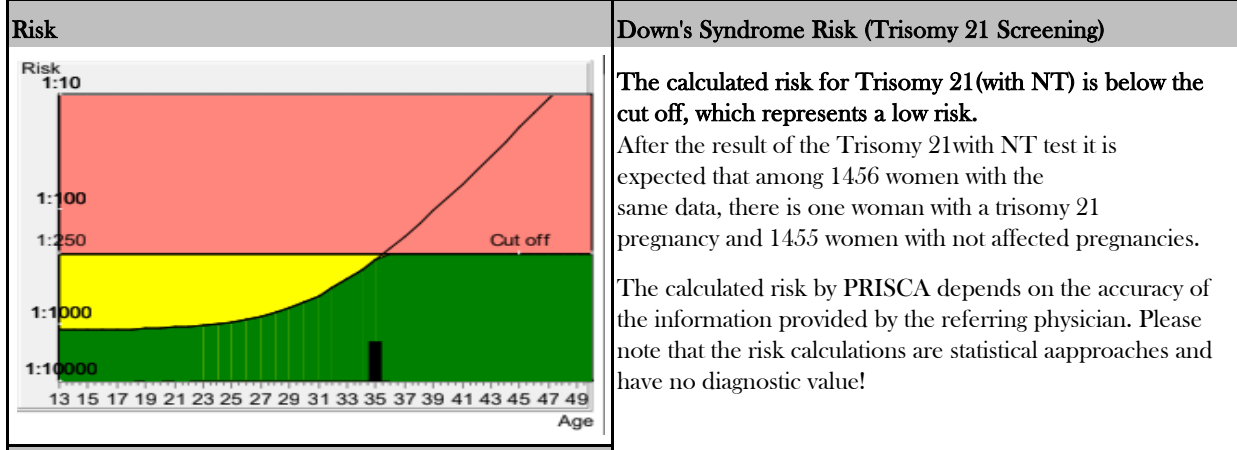

The calculated risk for Trisomy 21 (with NT) is below the cut off, which represents a low risk. After the result of the Trisomy 21 with NT test it is expected that among 1456 women with the same data, there is one woman with a trisomy 21 pregnancy and 1455 women with not affected pregnancies. The calculated risk by PRISCA depends on the accuracy of the information provided by the referring physician. Please note that the risk calculations are statistical approaches and have no diagnostic value!
