

			<p>The calculated risk for Trisomy 21 (with NT) is below the cut off, which represents a low risk.</p> <p>After the result of the Trisomy 21 test (with NT) it is expected that among 9385 women with the same data, there is one woman with a trisomy 21 pregnancy and 9384 women with not affected pregnancies.</p> <p>The calculated risk by PRISCA depends on the accuracy of the information provided by the referring physician. Please note that the risk calculations are statistical approaches and have no diagnostic value!</p> <p>The patient combined risk presumes that NT measurement was done according to accepted guidelines (Prenat Diagn 18:511-523; 1998).</p> <p>The laboratory cannot be hold responsible for their impact on the risk assessment!
