

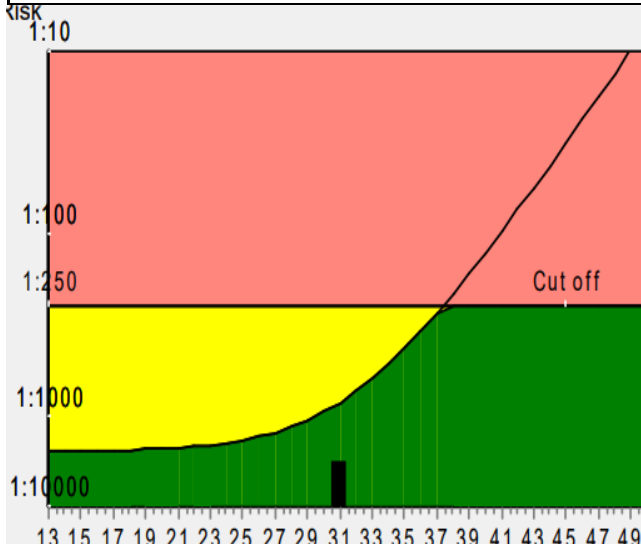

Gestational age	21+2	<b>The calculated risk for Trisomy 21 is below the cut off which represents a low risk.</b>	
Method	BPD (<>Hadlock)	After the result of the Trisomy 21 test it is expected that among 3800 women with the same data, there is one woman with a trisomy 21 pregnancy and 3800 women with not affected pregnancies.
