ULTRASOUND REPORT OF WHOLE ABDOMEN

Liver is normal in size and echo-texture. No obvious focal lesion is seen in liver parenchyma. Intra hepatic biliary channels are not dilated. Portal vein is normal. The CBD is not dilated.

Gall Bladder is not visualized (post-operative status).

Pancreas is normal in size & echotexture with no e/o focal lesion.

Spleen is normal in size and echotexture. No focal lesion is seen.

Right Kidney is normal in size, shape & echotexture. Cortico-medullary differentiation is well maintained. No e/o hydronephrosis is seen on right side. A calculus of size 3.9mm is noted in middle calyx of right kidney.

Left Kidney is normal in size, shape & echotexture. Cortico-medullary differentiation is well maintained. No e/o calculus or hydronephrosis is seen on left side. Few simple cysts are seen in left kidney, largest of size 15x15mm at mid pole.

Urinary bladder is well distended. A polypoidal lesion of size 11x9mm is seen in lumen of urinary bladder, adjacent to its left lateral wall.

Prostate is normal in size (20cc) and echo-texture with no e/o any focal lesion.

No e/o ascites or free fluid seen.

No e/o obvious abdominal lymphadenopathy is seen.

No USG e/o appendicitis is seen.

IMPRESSION

- > Right renal calculus.
- > Left renal simple cysts.
- > Polypoidal lesion in lumen of urinary bladder.

Adv: Cystoscopy and clinical correlation.
