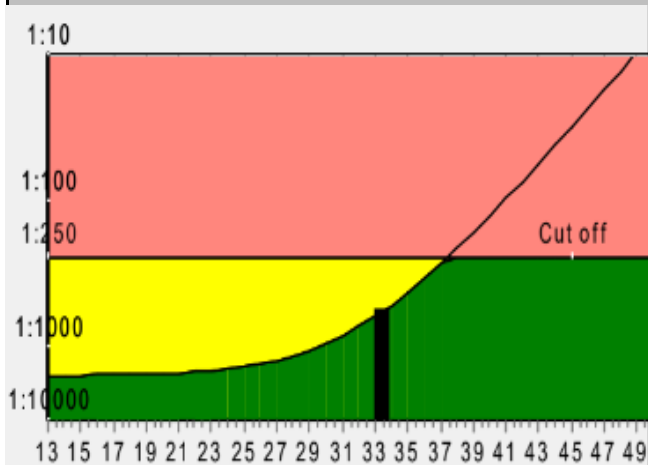

Method	BPD (Handlock)		After the result of the Trisomy 21 test it is expected that among 553 pregnancies with the same data, there is one trisomy 21 pregnancy and 552 women with not affected pregnancies. The risk for this twin pregnancy has been calculated for a singleton pregnancy with corrected MoMs. The calculated risk by PRISCA depends on the accuracy of the information provided by the referring physician. Please note that the risk calculations are statistical approaches and have no diagnostic value!
