ULTRASOUND REPORT OF WHOLE ABDOMEN

- Liver is enlarged in size and measures 15.1 cm in AP dimension. Mild diffuse increase in hepatic parenchyma echogenicity s/o – Grade I fatty liver.
- No obvious focal lesion is seen in liver parenchyma. Intra hepatic biliary channels are not dilated. Portal vein is normal. The CBD is not dilated.
- Gall bladder is normally distended. Multiple echogenic foci casting dense PAS leading to obscuration of posterior details are seen in lumen of gall bladder largest measuring 15.1mm s/o – Cholelithiasis.
- Pancreas is normal in size & echotexture with no e/o focal lesion.
- Spleen is normal in size and echotexture. No focal lesion is seen.
- Right Kidney is normal in size, shape & echotexture. Cortico-medullary differentiation is well maintained. No e/o calculus or hydronephrosis is seen on right side.
- Left Kidney is normal in size, shape & echotexture. Cortico-medullary differentiation is well maintained. No e/o calculus or hydronephrosis is seen on left side.
- Urinary bladder is well distended. The lumen is echofree with no e/o any calculus or mass lesion.
- Uterus is not visualized (Post Operative status).
- No e/o ascites seen. No e/o obvious abdominal lymphadenopathy is seen.

IMPRESSION

- Cholelithiasis.
- Mild hepatomegaly with grade I fatty liver.
