UPPER GI ENDOSCOPY Report

Informed consent was obtained from the patient after explaining all the benefits and risks of the procedure which the patient appeared to understand and so stated. The patient was connected to the monitoring devices and placed in left lateral position. The Endoscope (Olympus GIF 170) was advanced under direct visualisation.

Premedication : Xylocaine spray LA

Esophagus : Diaphragmatic hiatus at 35 cm, pgf at 34 cm, z line at 34 cm

OG Junction : 34 Cm, Hills grade 2

Stomach :

Fundus : Moderate PHG

Body : Moderate PHG

Antrum : Erosive antral gastritis, Thickened mucosa

Pylorus : Normal

Duodenum :

D1 : Erosions, Thickened mucosa

D2 : Normal

Biopsy : Taken from antrum

Impression : Moderate PHG, Erosive gastroduodenitis, RUT +ve, Thickened mucosa of stomach and duodenum (? Infiltrative disease)
